Are you a beginner?

Please call Centro Flamenco directly at 604-737-1273 for more information. We will happily answer any questions you have about flamenco dance and guitar instruction.

What do you teach?

All classes focus on flamenco technique in:

Compas (rhythms) *Brazos* (arms)
Zapateado (footwork) *Vueltas* (turns)
Palmas (clapping) *Pitos* (snapping)
Palillos (castanets)

When are your classes?

Fall September – December
Winter January – March
Spring April – June
Summer July and August

All class (except Baile) run on a once-per-week schedule. Children's classes are 60 minutes. Adult classes are 80 minutes.

Cancelled classes: No classes will be cancelled due to forecasted weather.

Long weekends: Classes run on all holiday weekends except by special arrangement.

What do I need?

Beginner students:

Women: Low-heeled shoes with hard soles and a wide skirt.

Men: Hard-soled shoes, short-sleeved shirt.

Although proper flamenco shoes are helpful in learning correct technique and protecting your feet, we recommend students try a few weeks of classes before investing in a quality pair of flamenco shoes.

Intermediate/Advanced students:

Flamenco shoes, skirt, castanets.

Recommended:

Various flamenco CDs for home study – available for purchase at the office.

Dress Code:

Hair tied back; leotards/tights worn.
